TERNA ENERGY signs a Memorandum of Understanding with Sinohydro Corporation and Industrial & Commercial Bank of China

Athens, June 19th, 2014: TERNA ENERGY, member of GEK TERNA Group, Sinohydro Corporation and Industrial & Commercial Bank of China (ICBC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding, today in Athens, Greece.

The Tripartite Cooperation Framework Agreement was signed during the commercial contracts signing ceremony that took place in the framework of the official visit of the Prime Minister of China Mr. Li Keqiang in Greece.

The MoU covers a partnership between the three Companies on investments in the Renewable Power sector in Greece. The first project under consideration is the "Amari Hybrid Scheme", a Power Complex in Crete Island, which combines wind and hydro operation for guaranteed capacity and electrical energy production.

TERNA ENERGY holds a leading position in the RES sector in Greece. The Group's total installed capacity amounts to 580 MW. The Group has 338 MW installed in Greece, 138 MW in the USA, 74 MW in Poland and 30 MW in Bulgaria.
